
Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

MSCA and Horizon Europe **requires Doctoral Network and COFUND projects** to publish the **adverts** for their positions on the EURAXESS portal. If the projects are audited, auditors have been asked to check whether these job ads have been published. It is advised to take screenshots of the advert for this reason.

For **Postdoctoral Fellowships**, researchers are *recommended* to look on EURAXESS for **hosting offers** from organisations. The researcher will then develop an application jointly with their chosen host organisation.

Job offers

Create offer posting

Every organisation member can add a new offer posting on behalf of the organisation he/she belongs to.

You can access this option either by the More dropdown menu in My Organisation(s) section in My EURAXESS page or by the Add button links at the top of your Organisation page. You need to fill the following sections:

Basic information

This section is mandatory. You need to fill in all required fields in order to save and publish your offer.

The fields you need to complete are:

- Title: The title that will appear in your job offer (limit 255 characters).
- Offer description: The description of your offer. You can use the editor's toolbar in order to make your description more attracting. Use bold, lists and headings to highlight the points you want. (limit 10000 characters).
- Researcher Profiles: This classification aims to communicate the various characteristics that researchers may have throughout
 their career. It describes four broad profiles that apply to all researchers, independent of where they work in the private or public
 sector: in companies, NGOs, research institutes, research universities or universities of applied sciences. Regardless of any
 particular profession one can outline broad profiles that describe the different characteristics researchers may possess:

1. First Stage Researcher (R1) - PhD candidate or equivalent. Early stage researcher with less than 4 years FTE research experience

2. Recognised Researcher (R2) - PhD holder or equivalent, not yet fully independent. Experienced Researcher with more than 4 years FTE research experience or has a doctoral degree

3. Established Researcher (R3) - Established Researcher with a developed level of independence. Experienced Researcher with more than 4 years FTE research experience or has a doctoral degree

4. Leading Researcher (R4) - Leading his/her research area or field

- Research fields: Select the research fields the offer involves. You can select a main research field and then a sub research field (leave it blank if you do not want to mention a sub field). Then click "ADD RESEARCH FIELD". You can add as many research fields as needed.
- Type of Contract: Permanent, Temporary or Other.
- · Job Status: Full-time, Part-time, Other or Not Applicable for example for fellowships.
- Application Deadline: The date up to which applications will be accepted. When the offer is expired, it will not appear in the results any more.
- Is the job funded through a EU Research Framework Programme?: Select the framework contract financing the offer. If you
 select a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Programme you nned also to specify the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Grant Agreement Number.
- Add destination countries for fellows?: For COFUND EU research framework programmes where a specific work location is not available, regions or countries may be selected as destination for fellows. To enable this option select a research framework that includes the "- COFUND" acronym in its description and check the "Add destination countries for fellows" check box. Then from the drop down list, below the checkbox, select the "Destination country/ies for fellows". You may select one or more
